# **MSP SCHOOL PHOTOS**


Our MSP School Photography Day is Thursday May 23. Information will be sent home early in Term 2.
















# **NATIONAL GALLERY ART CASES**

Daily session times - Tuesday 16 April through Thursday 18 April


10.00am start – 11.30am finish (1.5 hours) Age group: 8 – 12 years
